QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following are responses to the written questions submitted either at the RFP Orientation Session or received in writing by February 20, 2015, as specified in Section 1 of the RFP.

- Q1. Does the RFP expect to serve all the complex schools?
- A. **Applicants may serve any school(s) in the identified complexes. Applicants should consult and plan with schools they propose to serve.**
- Q2. Can the RFP target students who are “41-40” status?
- A. **Applicants may serve students who are at risk for truancy, suspension and expulsion. Applicants should consult and plan with schools they propose to serve.**
- Q3. What is the juvenile arrest data for schools in the Maui Complexes?
- A. **The arrest data were tracked by students’ residence and schools that shared the same zip code, and include all schools in the complex, i.e., elementary to high school. For more specific data by school, you may contact the school directly.**

- Q4. Who do you recommend we meet with to plan for the RFP services?

- A. Planning may involve school complex staff, including administration (principals and vice-principals), counselors, school resource officers, school based behavioral health, etc., who oversee and provide input to truancy prevention/intervention supports and services, and school disciplinary activities. Also, other community resources such as Maui Police Department, Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division, Department of Health, and Judiciary, may be considered.**
