HIV/AIDS HOUSING ASSISTANCE SERVICES STATEWIDE

In the fall of 2016, the Harm Reduction Services Branch, Communicable Disease and Public Health Nursing Division, Hawaii Department of Health (DOH), shall be issuing a Request for Proposals from qualified applicants to submit a proposal to provide HIV/AIDS housing assistance services throughout the state of Hawaii. The target population of this Request for Proposals is all HIV-positive individuals living in Hawaii. The DOH anticipates that a single contract shall be issued, which will be funded entirely with State funds. In anticipation of release of this Request for Proposals, the DOH shall be conducting a Request for Information (RFI). The purpose of this RFI is to seek input and comments on the planned statewide housing assistance services. The RFI will be held on September 1, 2016, at 1:30 p.m., in the conference room of the Harm Reduction Services Branch, 728 Sunset Boulevard, Honolulu, Hawaii.
