1. **My question is regarding the Provider Performance Bonus on page 2-9, section 8a. Please clarify how you will measure the reduction of the pool count. If the 50% reduction of the pool is achieved within the sixth month period, but at the last day of the sixth month it is not 50% less than the initial pool count, will the contractor still be eligible for the bonus?**

No, the pool count shall be established by the Department as of the first day of the contract, or the first day the contractor is able to provide services, whichever is first and the Department shall measure the 50% pool reduction as of the last day of the sixth month to determine eligibility for the one-time performance bonus of \$1500 to the Provider.
