This award is conditioned on the following:

- 1) Submission of the following documents to the Kauai Division of Forestry and Wildlife office within ten (10) working days from the date of this letter:
 - a. A copy of the State of Hawaii (State) Department of Taxation tax clearance certificate (Form A-6) with an original green certified copy stamp;
 - b. A copy of the State Department of Labor and Industrial Relations certificate of compliance with Section 3-122-112, Hawaii Administrative Rules (Form #LIR27);
 - c. A copy of the State Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs Business Registration Division "Certificate of Good Standing"

Alternately, you may choose to use the Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE), which allows businesses to register online through a simple wizard interface at <http://vendors.ehawaii.gov> to acquire a "Certificate of Vendor Compliance." Please refer to the RFP for details on the above requirements and how to obtain the certificates. If you are unable to provide the above documents by the deadline, a request to extend the due date may be considered by this office. An extension may or may not be granted depending on the urgency of the procurement.

- 2) Successful execution of a contract.

After the contract is signed by the State, you will receive a "Notice to Proceed" that will designate the official starting date. This notice of award is issued as the first step in the award process. For a variety of reasons, the State may find cause for cancellation of the award, thus the State is not liable for any work, contract, costs, expenses, loss of profit, or any damages whatsoever incurred by your company until the contract has been fully executed by the State and the Notice to Proceed has been issued.
